### ENTRY VISA FOR SPOUSE

Vietnamese citizens married to Norwegians can apply for entry visa to Norway with the purpose of applying for residence/work permit in Norway. Processing time is 4-four-weeks. This processing time cannot be shortened. The visa ensures valid stay for a seven days period, in which application for a residence/work permit has to be submitted to the local police office. The applicant can stay in Norway while the application for residence/work permit is under consideration. Be advised that EEA nationals working in Norway or other permanent residents of Norway, who have been residing in Norway for 3-three-years and married to the applicant for at least 3-three-years, can apply for entry visa to Norway with the purpose of applying for residence/work permit in Norway. **The following documentation is required:**

*Please check the boxes below and sign to confirm which documents you have submitted*

- Visa application form duly completed with one passport photo** ( 2 inches in size, white background)
- Supplementary form for family relationship** (mandatory to be submitted with the application)
- Original and copy of relevant pages of the passport** (also previous visas to Schengen)
- Original and copy of previous passports** (if any)
- Documentation from the Norwegian spouse:**
  - Copy of the passport**
  - A written statement from the Norwegian spouse (in Norwegian) explaining the relationship between the two parties prior to entering into marriage. This letter should be as detailed as possible.**
  - Verification of residence (bostedsattest)**
  - Verification from the Central People Registrar showing marital status (Sentrale Folkeregister)**
  - Copy of Divorce Certificate (if any)**
  - Copy of Certificate of no impediment to Marriage (Attest til bruk for ekteskapsinngåelse etter utenlandsk rett)**
  - Documentation of income by copy of 3-three latest payment letters for salary or benefits and last available tax payment slip (ligningsattest) (minimum NOK 215.200,-/year as of 21 July 2008)**
- Documentation from the applicant presented to the Embassy:**
  - A written statement from the Vietnamese spouse (in Vietnamese) explaining the relationship between the two parties prior to entering into marriage. This letter should be as detailed as possible**
  - Verified translation and copy of Marriage Certificate \* + 1-one copy of the verified translation \***
  - Verified translation and copy of ID-card \***
  - Verified translation and copy of all pages of Household Registration \***
  - Verified translation and copy of Birth certificate \***
  - Verified translation and copy of documentation proving change of name (if any) \***
  - Verified translation and copy of documentation proving dissolving of previous marriage (if any) \***
  - List of all family members (attached to the application form). This list does not need to be legalized.**
  - If you are under 20, you must also submit a verified translation and copy of a letter of consent signed by both parents \***

**\* The translation shall be into English and the verification made by Vietnamese Ministry of Foreign Affairs**  
*Supporting documentation must be submitted together with the application, by the applicant personally. Supporting documentation sent to the Embassy without reference to a registered application will not be considered, and made waste. The application will be refused if the documentation submitted is incomplete.*

I hereby confirm that I personally have submitted this application for an entry visa and that all information stated in the application and the supporting documentation is true. I am aware that providing incorrect information or falsified documents deliberately are punishable acts by both Vietnamese and Norwegian law.
